## APPLICANTS FOR THE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Legal resident of the U.S. no less than eighteen (18) years of age.
- 2. Must have a high school diploma, G.E.D., C.H.S.E., or transcripts showing graduation date.
- 3. Must have legal state-issued birth certificate (not hospital certificate).
- 4. Veterans should provide copy of DD-214 or discharge papers.
- 5. Survey applicants must have educational background in Algebra and Geometry.
- Proof of work experience, applicable to the program, may be presented (on company letterhead) detailing hours/years of equipment operated/ work performed; Trade school certificates or letters may also be presented.

Note: Any submitted documents that are printed in a language other than English must be accompanied by a notarized English translation.

Must "show" picture I.D. Valid driver's license required upon entry into the program.

**Application & Testing** will be done at the William C. Waggoner Training Center located at 6350 Howdy Wells Avenue, Las Vegas. Take I-15 north to Exit 54 (Speedway/Hollywood Boulevards). Turn Right on Hollywood (before Speedway fence). Go approximately 2 miles to Howdy Wells Avenue. Turn right. Go west to the training site parking lot at the end of the road.
